



Middle School Supply List (grade 6) & Recommendations (grades 7/8)

Grade 6:

Ancient History – Mr. Dornan

- 1” binder, 6 dividers, & loose-leaf paper OR a 1-2 subject notebook

Earth Science – Mr. Nolan

- 1” binder, 6 dividers, & loose-leaf paper OR a 1-2 subject notebook
- 12-inch ruler and protractor

Intro. to Latin – Ms. Fitzgerald

- 1” binder, 6 dividers, & loose-leaf paper OR a 1-2 subject notebook
- Index cards (lined or blank, colored or white)
- Designated place to store index cards (could be a 3-ring binder pencil pouch: [Binder Pouch](#) or a plastic or metal container, such as: [Index Card Storage Box](#) (please note that these are often dropped and break easily), [Soft Plastic Storage Container](#))

Literature (Great Books) – Mr. Dornan

- 1” binder, 6 dividers, & loose-leaf paper OR a 1-2 subject notebook
- [Tales of Greek Heroes](#) by Roger Lancelyn Green (summer reading requirement)
- [The Lion, The Witch, & The Wardrobe](#) by C.S. Lewis (this will be needed in September)
- Multiple novels will be needed throughout the school year. The instructor will inform families when to purchase each. Amazon links are provided, but books can be purchased anywhere. Purchasing used books is the most economical option (no abridged versions).

Math 6 – Ms. Fitzgerald

- 1” binder with notebook paper and dividers OR a 1-2 subject notebook
- Ruler
- Graph paper (can be stored in a section of the binder or a separate graph paper notebook can be used)
- Calculators are NOT needed.

Music – Mrs. Horvath

- 1” binder (for Music class only) with 3 dividers and loose-leaf paper
- Sharpened graphite and colored pencils, highlighter, eraser

Physical Education/Healthy Living – Coach Cottle

- PE uniform (for daily P.E.) – non P.E. uniform athletic clothing is not permitted
- Athletic shoes (any color/style athletic shoes) – it is recommended that students have a pair of school uniform shoes and a pair of P.E. shoes
- Fitness journal – this can be a one subject notebook, a small journal, etc.

Spelling/Grammar – Mrs. Jandorf

- Required textbook: [Grammar Workbook](#)
- 1” binder with 4-6 dividers & loose-leaf paper OR 1 subject notebook or composition notebook



Theology (Great Bible Stories) – Mrs. Noland

- Required textbook: [Great Adventure Catholic Bible Chronicles](#)
- 1” binder filled with loose-leaf paper OR 1 subject notebook or composition notebook

Other required supplies to be used across multiple classes:

- Student planner with ample daily/weekly writing space in the monthly calendar sections
- Pencil pouch/container (something easy to transport outside of backpack)
- Pencils (wooden or mechanical with extra lead)
- Ink pens (black and/or blue pens are suggested, but other colors may be used, as well)
- Highlighters
- 1 pack of colored pencils, colored gel pens, or markers
- Erasers (pencil top and/or handheld)
- Extra loose-leaf paper for binders (wide or college-ruled)
- Glue stick or glue dots
- Small pair of scissors (must fit inside pencil pouch)
- Tape in a dispenser (such as Scotch tape found in a plastic dispenser)
- If students do not prefer to write in books (for annotation purposes), they may instead purchase writable sticky note tags/flags.



Grades 7 & 8 Supply Suggestions

Teachers will provide a class syllabi the first two days of school. Most of the below will be needed based on previous years, but teachers may make specific requests not listed below.

Supplies to be used across multiple classes:

- 1” binder with dividers & loose-leaf paper OR a 1-2 subject notebook for EACH class
- Folders with clasps for handouts for EACH class (not required if using a binder)
- Student planner with ample daily/weekly writing space in the monthly calendar sections
- Pencil pouch/container (something easy to transport outside of backpack)
- Pencils (wooden or mechanical with extra lead)
- Black and/or blue pens (other colors are allowed for taking notes)
- Highlighters (3 different colors)
- 1 pack of colored pencils, colored gel pens, or markers
- Erasers (pencil top and/or handheld)
- Extra loose-leaf paper for binders (wide or college-ruled)
- Glue stick or glue dots and/or tape in a dispenser
- Small pair of scissors (must fit inside pencil pouch)
- If students do not prefer to write in books (for annotation purposes), they may instead purchase writable sticky note tags/flags.
- Index cards (white or colored, lined or blank) for Latin vocabulary and for studying for other classes
- Designated place to store index cards (could be a 3-ring binder pencil pouch: [Binder Pouch](#) or a plastic or metal container, such as: [Soft Plastic Storage Container](#) or [Index Card Storage Box](#) (please note that these are often dropped and break easily)
- Catholic Bible - any edition, but the NRSVCE translation is recommended – see the USCCB website for more info: [USCCB Approved Bible Translations](#)
- For Math: Graph-ruled filler paper (min. 50 sheets) or a graph paper notebook, ruler, and protractor
- For Music: sharpened graphite and colored pencils
- P.E. Fitness journal – this can be a 1 subject notebook, a small journal, etc.

Notes:

- Supplies are not needed until the first full week of school (Aug. 17).
- All students are responsible for their own supplies. Student supplies can be organized as they find most helpful to them for each class.
- Required reading material for specific classes will be listed on the class syllabus.
- If students choose binders for most classes, subjects taught by the same teacher and/or related subjects (i.e. math/science) may be combined in 2”- 4” binders with clear division & organization between subjects.
- If students choose binders, they can be any type (hard, soft, zipped, Velcro, etc.).
- Backpacks are recommended but must be stored in the locker. Rolling backpacks are not permitted.
- Loose leaf paper and notebooks may be college or wide ruled.
- Students may decorate their lockers minimally. Locker shelves are highly recommended. Locks for lockers are not permitted. Stickers on lockers are not permitted.
